



What is Children Family and Community General?

The Children, Family and the Community General course focuses on factors that influence human development and the wellbeing of individuals, families and communities. Students develop an understanding of human growth and the domains of development. Students are introduced to the diverse nature and interdependence of societal groups. They develop an appreciation of how the creation of environments that promote optimal growth and development of individuals, families and communities affect and influence society as a whole. Students will communicate and interact with children, families and community groups in practical ways. They will come to understand that beliefs, values and ethics influence decisions made by individuals, families, and communities.

How will Children Family and Community General help me in the future?

This course caters for students seeking career pathways in areas, such as education, nursing, community services, childcare and health.

What content will I study in Year 11 and Year 12?

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| <p>Children Family and Community General Unit 1 <i>This unit focuses on family uniqueness. Students examine the role of families and the relationships between individuals, families and their communities. Through an understanding of growth and development, students recognise the characteristics of individuals and families and that development is affected by biological and environmental influences.</i></p> | <p>Children Family and Community General Unit 2 <i>This unit focuses on families, relationships and living in communities. The influence of biological and environmental factors, lifestyle behaviours and health status on growth and development is studied. Students explore the health of individuals and communities and the protective and preventative strategies that impact on growth and development.</i></p> |

| <p>Children Family and Community General Unit 3: <i>In this unit, students investigate the principles of development and how these relate to the domains and theories of development. Students examine and evaluate the features of products, services and systems for individuals and families. They examine the diverse and dynamic nature of families in Australia.</i></p> | <p>Children Family and Community General Unit 4: <i>In this unit, students examine the effect on an individual's development and wellbeing in a society characterised by rapid change. They explore contemporary Australian issues or trends relating to families. Students examine developmental theories and their influence on cognitive development.</i></p> |
